



Speakers

Rev. John Bersche was born in 1938, the fourth son of a preacher. John has been a pastor/evangelist, and gospel singer since 1960.

He is President of Learning To Live, a Canadian charity, since 1976.

John had the privilege of a personal moment with Mother Teresa in Calcutta in 1982. They shared their common faith in Jesus Christ and their 'call to ministry'.

Rev. Gordon Williams is a Pastor and Evangelist who operates in the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

He holds a M.Div. degree from Princeton Theological Seminary and was first ordained by the United Church of Canada.
